Credit Card Usage Restrictions in Sanctioned Countries

Your RBC Royal Bank credit card is accepted virtually anywhere you travel throughout the world, except in certain countries that are subject to economic and trade sanctions imposed by regulatory bodies and otherwise.

As a result of current economic sanctions in place by the Office of Foreign Assets Control of the United States Department of the Treasury (US OFAC) on Iran, Cuba, North Korea, Sudan and Myanmar (Burma), you will no longer be able to utilize our US denominated credit cards in any of these sanctioned countries. Kindly note that card activity in Syria has also been suspended due to recently expanded sanctions and as such, international Cardholders can no longer use their cards at ATMs or merchant locations in Syria.

For your information, we advise that we are required to comply with US OFAC sanctions, since our US Dollar Visa & MasterCard International transactions are settled through a US Correspondent Bank, which is required to comply with US OFAC rules. As a result, we would be unable to process these transactions.
