2. Connecting your terminal



- Attach the power line to the bottom of the terminal, ensuring that the cord is passed under the terminal clip.
- 2 Connect the power cord to the power adaptor
- Plug into the wall socket.


3. Installing the paper

- 3 PINPad (upon request)


- 1 Push down the button to the right side of the printer cover, to open.

4. Connecting the PINPad (if required)




1 Attach the RS 232 end of the PINPad cord to the PINPad port on the bottom of the terminal.

5. Connecting the telephone cord or LAN cable



1 For LAN - Plug the LAN cable into the 10baseT port of the terminal and the other end into the LAN device.



2 For Dialup - Plug the phone line into the phone port under the terminal and into the wall outlet.

6. Using your terminal



- 1 Place the terminal on a flat solid surface.
- 2 Swipe the bank card through the card slot and perform a transaction.
